Here is some information about our FUNancial Kid's Camp that you should find interesting.

- The camp is sponsored by the Fleet and Family Support Center and this will be the 8<sup>th</sup> Annual FUNancial Summer Day.
- This camp is hosted every year to teach money basics to our military youth. It is open for kids age 5-12, and each day consists of healthy, safe and fun learning.
- Our participants learn about:
  - How to make money: Jobs and businesses
  - How to manage money: budgets
  - How to multiply their money: savings and investing
  - How to develop the habits of a wealthy person; develop passive income streams by investing assets and how money can be used to give back and help their communities grow.

- The camp is run by the Personal Financial Management Team that consists of 3 accredited financial counselors based out of FFSC.

**IMPORTANT:** this camp is completely **FREE** to our families, and because we don't have a budget for this event, we have looked to our community partners for support.

We are very excited this year to have been offered support from your organization.

With our community partner support, we have seen exponential growth from just 4 years ago. The attendance has doubled, and we have had to put a cap on the number of participants that we can accommodate each year.
