Missing for 70 years, the USS R-12 has been found at 600 ft on the ocean floor off Key West FL with 42 entombed sailors.

The WWII submarine USS R-12 (SS-89) sank off the coast of Key West, Florida at mid-day on June 12, 1943. She took forty American sailors and two Brazilian officers to their grave at 600 ft on the ocean floor. They have been missing for nearly seventy years until found by a team of explorers working with state of the art technology and fascinated by her story and the mystery.

She is the sixth WWII US submarine to be found of the fifty-two missing and the only US Sub to sink within the continental United States.
